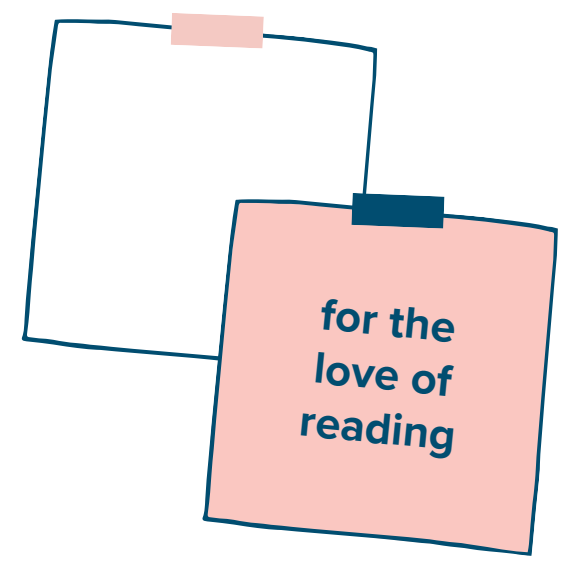

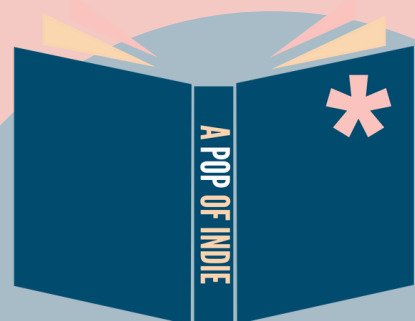
OUR VISION

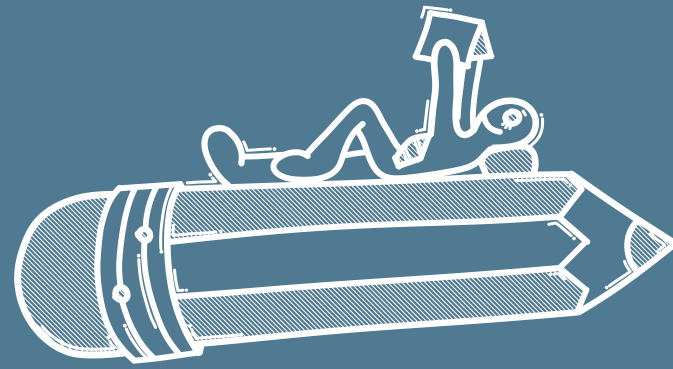

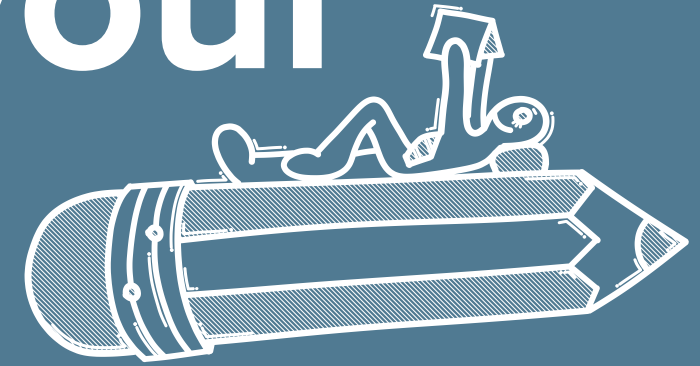
